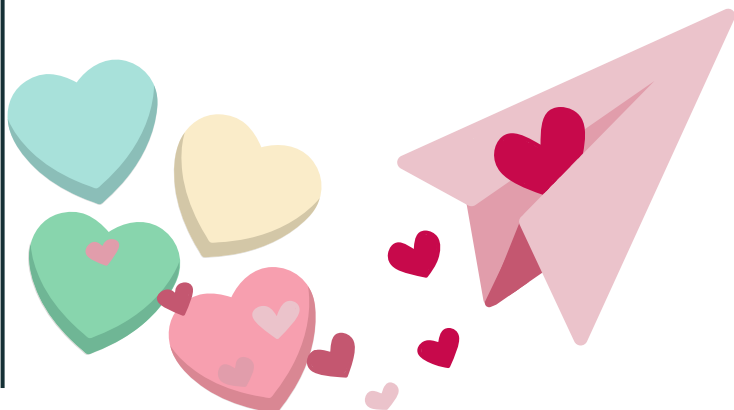

January 21, 2025

- **Call to Order** at 6pm- Karen
- **Devotions**

- **Agenda – Modifications and Approval**
 - Motion to approve – Diane, Second – Kortney
- **Approval of Minutes from Council Meeting on December 17th**
 - The date will be corrected from December 16th to December 17th.
 - Motion to approve with the modification – Nancy, Second – Elaine
- **Receive Treasurer’s Report**
 - There are a couple of line items that have already hit 50% of the budget used but we are only 4 months into our fiscal year. Kitchen supplies is at 165%, social media staff salary is at 53%, pulpit supply is at 135% used, and choir music at 81% used. These are just a couple of the items that are considered at risk already. Some line items may even out at the end of the fiscal year. We need to start being very specific when turning in receipts. Make sure you are putting where Craig should take from. If we are not specific, Craig is unsure where to put some items and he must guess.
 - We still want to see youth’s fundraising and trip expenses on their own separate page. We have already made a motion to make this change in a previous month’s meeting. Karen will speak with Craig.
 - No motion to approve as the Treasurer is out.
- **Guests**
 - Darin Stenvold came to give a presentation on what an app could do and what it would look like for Faith. The app would cost \$500 to get up and running, and \$49 a month to keep updated. This is a great price that Darin can get for us. The app could be used for digital connection cards, requesting a visit with Pastor, prayer requests, event calendars, online giving, volunteer signups, bible studies, and much more.
- **Pastor’s Report**
 - Key items-
 - 2 baptisms coming up. The Pastor in Hinckley has asked Pastor Josh to baptize their child and he has agreed.
 - Josh and the other local pastors are working to replan Pizza w/ Pastors as it may be more expensive than they originally thought.
 - Christmas went well.
 - Lent is quickly approaching, and Pastor Josh has a new idea this year to get more people coming. It will include a bible/book study that the congregation can do at home. We will also have Lenten services during a meal on Wednesday’s. More info to come later.
 - Motion to approve that we agree to proceed with Pastor’s plan for Lenten services which includes the purchase of 10 books that will be reimbursed by donations from members – Nancy, Second – Elaine

- VBS- In brainstorming between Camp Onomia and Pastor, they decided to pencil us in for VBS at Camp Onomia for the week this year. All counselors would be there for us and everything there would be included. This would look to be roughly \$45 per child for the week. More info to come closer to.
- **Old Business:**

 2. Personnel Policy, Employees – Pastor Rollie has agreed to come to the next meeting in February. We would like to make the next council meeting an education forum for the congregation to come and listen to him. He will be here to address the concerns and for us to hear why the synod has their recommendation of church employees not serving on council. This would be an hour informational session with a shortened council meeting to follow. It was asked that we see if Pastor Rollie can come on a Sunday after service instead. We will reach out to him about this and let the congregation know.
 3. Parking Lot – We need to start looking at finding someone to repair our parking lot.
 4. Parking Lot Lights Quotes – We are waiting to hear back from Leach about a quote. We have a quote from Live Wire Electrical Services for \$1,230. We will wait for Leach's quote.
 5. App for Faith – Motion to approve going forward with the purchase of an app for Faith through Darin Stenvold – Natasha, Diane – Second

 6. RIC Retreat- Reconciling and Christ on Saturday, January 25th. We have 25 people signed up to join us. Food will be provided by Local & Global committee members.
 7. Discussion on Council Vacancy- Waiting to hear from a candidate.

Online Ministry: Serving Virtually

From Council President Karen Gabriel:

Did you know that Faith has a growing online ministry? There are several people that worship regularly online with us and Sunday morning, and many more that view our worship service during the week. In fact, the ELCA has a formula for determining how many people are worshipping virtually. This formula provides a consistent way to count those participating virtually. Reporting virtual attendance is required as is reporting the number of people physically attending a worship service. Providing online worship reaches people beyond the walls of our church building and grows the Kingdom of God.

The formula for online worship attendance:

$$\begin{aligned}
 &(\text{Number of live worship viewers} \times 2) + (\text{Number of} \\
 &\text{worship views until the next Sunday morning} \times 2) \\
 &= \text{Number of weekly online worship}
 \end{aligned}$$

Psalm 90:17.*

God calls each of us out of our comfort zone to serve him. Psalm 90 invites us to pray and trust that God will use our life in some way to serve him. He constantly opens doors and provides plenty of opportunities for all of us to serve him by bringing help and hope to others. We might not always be watchful of all that is happening around us or of what needs to be done. Maybe it is helping to keep the church and grounds looking nice, or being involved in some way with the many ministry programs and activities within the church. It can even be the little acts of kindness we do for others and the simple interactions we share with those around us. God does not limit our serving to the church. He also opens doors outside of the church for us to serve him within our community and neighborhoods, in the workplace, in our schools, within our own family, and anywhere we might be.

Somewhere, right now, there's an open door waiting for you to serve. So, be watchful for the opportunities God places in front of you. Pray that your eyes will be opened and God will guide you to make the most out of every opportunity that comes your way. For what you do today, will have a lasting impact on the lives of the people you touch along your life path.

It's not a matter of whether God opens doors. It's a matter of what doors he opens and whether or not you are willing to walk through them.
