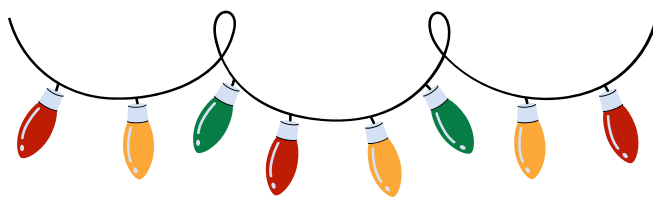

Now let us share that gift with those around us. What better gift can we give others this Christmas than to show Christ's love through what we do.

When we live ready, when we live watchfully and prayerfully, we will be able to bear fruit in opportunities that come our way.
